9th June 2018

07:05 Vsl psn 35°22.9'N 014°51.4'E. COG 190°. SOG 10kts. Received Sat phone call from IMRCC requesting vsl's psn and heading.

07:07 Received Sat phone call from IMRCC with instruction to proceed towards Farwah Oilfield to assist in SAR ops with full speed.

07:24 Run up 3rd engine. Proceeding with full speed towards Farwah Oilfield.

10:17 Received Inmarsat-C distress alert about SAR case 391, rubber boat adrift in psn 33°26'N 013°47'E at 09:45, departed from Garabulli - Libya. Reported about 150ppl on board.

10:24 Sat phone call to IMRCC. MV Aquarius is instructed to divert its course and proceed to SAR case 391.

MV Aquarius proceeds to distress psn at maximum speed, ETA to distress psn 18:45.

11:00 Sat phone call to IMRCC. Received additional information on SAR case 391.

12:45 Sat phone call to IMRCC. Received information that MV Asso Ventiquattro is OSC for SAR case 391 and is proceeding to distress psn with ETA 16:00. Received information that rubber boat has been spotted by EUNAVFOR MED aircraft and confirmed to be adrift in abovementioned position.

13:50 Received from IMRCC via email the Action Plan for SAR case 391.

14:25 Established VHF ch.16/10 communication with MV Asso 24.

14:30 Established VHF ch.16/10 communication with MT Anwar Al Khalij, which is in psn 33°29.2'N 013°44.8'E and reports to be at 2 Nm from the rubber boat SAR 391.

14:50 Received on Inmarsat-C handover reference from IMRCC, informing that Libyan Coast Guard assumes responsibility on SAR case 391.

14:55 Received Sat phone call from IMRCC. MV Aquarius is instructed to proceed to psn 34°00'N 013°00'E for RDV with ITCG patrol vessels CP267, CP319, CP312 in order to perform transfer operation of approx. 280 rescued people onto MV Aquarius.

15:05 Vessel position 34°09'N 013°59'E, start proceeding to RDV.

15:35 Vessel position 34°08'N 013°52'E, received Sat. phone call from IMRCC with information that 2 rubber boats with about 120 persons on board each have been spotted few minutes before by EUNAVFOR MED aircraft in position 33°41'N 013°57'E. Both rubber boats reported to be underway heading north at approx.

4 kts. Designated SAR cases 392 and 393. MV Aquarius instructed to proceed to perform rescue operation on these 2 rubber boats.

17:04 Vsl psn 33°51.9'N 013°54.8'E. Received sat. phone call from IMRCC with information that ENFM Helicopter is approaching the distress area, ETA 1745.

17:40 Vsl psn 33°45.7'N 013°56.9'E radar and visual contact with 2 targets in psn 33°45.5'N 013°57.0'E, approx. 4 Nm from MV Aquarius. Sat phone call to IMRCC to report, received confirmation to initiate rescue operation.

Weather on scene: wind N 5 kts, waves less than 0,5 m, temperature 23°C, good visibility.

18:12 Vsl psn 33°42.4'N 013°57.3'E. RHIB 1 and 2 in the water, start rescue operation.

18:20 Received sat. phone call from IMRCC with instruction to collect 119 rescued persons from MV Jolly Vanadio upon completion of rescue operation.

18:40 RHIB1 delivers 1st shuttle of rescued persons on board MV Aquarius.

18:55 Received written instruction via email from IMRCC to transship onto MV Aquarius n. 119 migrants on board of M/V JOLLY VANADIO (case EV SAR n. 395), n. 286 migrants from Italian CPVs CP319, CP 267, CP

312, (cases EV SAR n. 386, n. 388, n. 390) upon completion of ongoing rescue operation.

22:10 Vsl psn 33°42.6'N 013°52.5'E. Established VHF contact with Italian Navy helicopter arriving on scene.

22:40 Received sat. phone call from IMRCC to update situation. Italian Navy ship San Giusto is approaching to provide assistance.

22:43 Received VHF call from RHIBs of San Giusto. Informed that ETA to rescue scene is in 10 minutes.

22:52 Received VHF call from CP312 approaching the scene.

23:10 RHIB 2 out of order and recovered on deck.

23:16 Last shuttle of rescued persons delivered on board MV Aquarius. Sat. phone call to IMRCC to update situation. Received instructions on the transfer operations to carry out from ITCG CPs.

23:30 Rescue rafts recovered on deck.

23:55 RHIB 1 recovered on deck.

10th June 2018

Weather on scene: wind SE 5 kts, waves less than 0,5 m, temperature 23°C, good visibility.

00:20 Vsl psn 33°43.0'N 013°50.6'E. CP312 alongside MV Aquarius. Start transfer operation.

00:40 Completed transfer of 129 rescued persons from CP312 (SAR case 388)

00:45 CP319 alongside MV Aquarius. Start transfer operation.

00:50 Completed transfer of 64 rescued persons from CP319 (SAR case 390)

01:02 Start transfer operation from CP267.

01:16 Completed transfer of 88 rescued persons from CP267 (SAR case 386, previously recovered from MV Vos Thalassa). Sat phone call to IMRCC to report situation. Agreed to perform the transfer operation of rescued persons from MV Jolly Vanadio using the landing craft LCM68 from Italian Navy ship San Giusto.

01:19 Awaiting approach of MV Jolly Vanadio for transfer operation.

01:50 Vsl psn 33°41.3'N 013°51.4'E; 1 Nm from MV Jolly Vanadio. Awaiting commence transfer operation.

02:35 Vsl psn. 33°41.2'N 013°51.4'E; Landing craft LCM68 from Italian Navy ship San Giusto alongside port side.

Weather on scene: wind SE 5 kts, waves less than 0,5 m, temperature 23°C, good visibility.

02:38 Commenced transfer operation from LCM68.

02:48 Completed transfer operation of 119 rescued persons.

02:51 LCM68 cast off.

02:52 Sat phone call to IMRCC to report completion of all transfer operations. MV Aquarius is instructed to start proceeding North towards a Place of Safety to be designated.
